Dear Friends,

This year marks 6 years of celebrating Pride in Yonkers!

June is LGBTQ History Month, better known as Pride Month. It is a month-long celebration of people in the LGBTQIA+ community, their identities, and contributions to society. It is also a time of remembrance for those who fought for acceptance and change. The Stonewall riots in June of 1969 were the start of a movement we now call Pride.

At least 417 anti-LGBTQ bills have been introduced in state legislatures across the United States since the start of the year. That's more than twice the number of bills introduced in all of last year. The fight continues to combat homophobic and transphobic legislation.

This year Yonkers Pride is celebrating "Love YO Pride." This theme reflects the vibrant LGBTQIA+ community in Yonkers and solidifies our city as a safe and inclusive city. To commemorate this year's theme, a special edition T-Shirt will be released during Pride.

We hope that Yonkers Pride gives visibility to the LGBTQIA+ community in our area, an opportunity to our allies to learn about our community and show their support, and a chance for families and individuals struggling with LGBTQIA+ identity issues to understand and accept their loved ones and themselves for who they are, as well as to appreciate that our pride in our identity makes us strong and able to overcome our fears of being who we are.






